

RECOMMEND A RESOURCE BE ADDED TO PAVILION

Simulation Recommendation

Simulations present the user with a story-based mission where they must identify and/or apply skills by answering a series of questions. Upon completion they are given a score and recommended remediation. The user can choose from one to three paths to take, each having their own unique questions. This allows the user to repeat the simulation but experience a different scenario. For example, the mission could be centered around a crisis and each path represents one of the following:

- Roles (e.g., Mission Partner Support, PA Media Operations and Crisis Action Team Member)
- Events (e.g., a hurricane approaches, the hurricane hits, the hurricane passes)
- Products (e.g., interview, social media strategy, and communication plan)

Using the above example of the path options being different roles during a crisis, the user would choose one of the roles from the list and then answer three questions specific to that path (e.g., responsibilities during a crisis for a Crisis Action Team Member). Users will select an answer choice for each question and feedback will display depending on whether it is correct or incorrect.

During the simulation, users can access resources to reference as part of the questions to complete their mission. For example, fact sheets, maps, sample communication plans, press releases, photos, etc. These resources are optional. View an example simulation with three paths on PAVILION.
